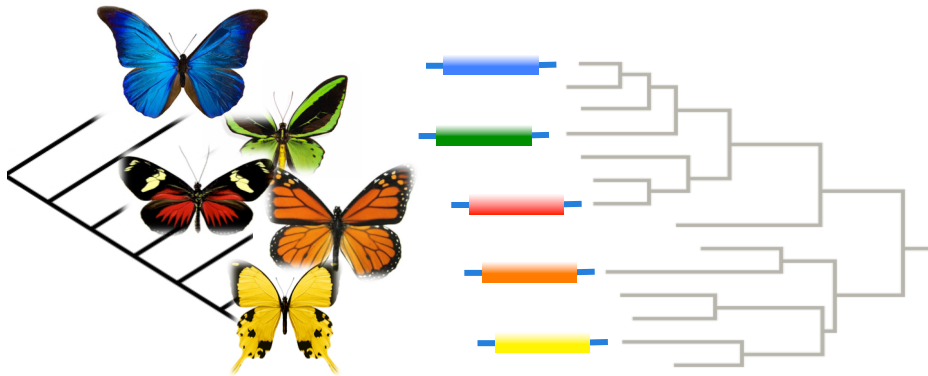


Postdoctoral position in Host-transposon interactions
